Re: Clinical trial of BRH treatment on chronic venous ulcers

My name is Dr. Eyal Shapira, Plastic Surgeon, Director, Wound Service, Assaf Harofe Medical Center

In the last few months we have been conducting research on patients at our hospital with venous ulcerations.

Venous ulcers are a serious disease, which causes patients significant pain because of chronic non healing where there is disproportionate pain. These ulcers affect the daily living and quality of life of these patients.

The BRH-A2 system combines Ultrasound and electric fields technologies which creates a micromassaging effect in the treated tissue enhancing blood flow to the treatment area and to the wound as well.

To date we have treated 7 patients in the trial. All had surprisingly good results after just 8 treatments that were given twice weekly over 4 weeks.

I was personally very impressed with this technology's ability to accelerate the healing rates in these stalled chronic wounds.

The rapid healing rate is something that I have not encountered with any other technology to date.
