In 2015 we were approached by BRH Medical to take part in the trial of a new device for chronic wound treatment.

They introduced their groundbreaking technology, which combines the use of ultrasound and electrostimulation to promote the healing of chronic wounds.

At that stage we were hesitant to use "the unknown", but decided to give the device a try.

One of our residents at Sandringham Gardens — BL- suffered enormously for 2 years from a large non-healing leg ulcer and during that course of time had undergone a number of surgeries, debridement's and grafts with little or no success. We felt that she was the perfect candidate to trial the machine.

Within weeks her wound started to get smaller and after few months it had completely closed and healed.

Since then, we have treated over 15 patients utilizing the BRH device and have really noted a significant change in their wounds.

We are still using the BRH treatment successfully for many of our residents and are happy to recommend it for the treatment of chronic wounds.
